- City of Berkeley Special Election for District 7 | Tuesday, April 16, 2024
  - Currently in the canvass period (processing all Vote By Mail Ballots including the Plus Mail that has been received up through April 23<sup>rd</sup> provided that are postmarked w/E-Day date of April 16).
- City of Berkeley Special Election for District 4 | Tuesday, May 28, 2024
- Sunol Glen Unified School District Special Recall Election | Tuesday, July 02, 2024
  - Two School Board Members being recalled.
- District Attorney Recall - Election date is to be determined
  - Petition for the recall was found to be sufficient.
  - Alameda County Board of Supervisors will receive the Certificate of Sufficiency at its next regular meeting (April 30, 2024).

### III. YOUTH VOTING

- City of Oakland Measure QQ
- City of Berkeley Measure Y1
- Passed by Voters
  - To allow 16- and 17-year-olds (who pre-register as a voter), to vote in School Board Director elections only.
- Implementation of elections to be included w/the November 2024 General Election
  - The Registrar of Voters, the cities, school districts, and the Election Management System vendor are working together to form an agreement and to develop the Custom Build software to support youth voting.
  - Develop a youth voting outreach plan.

Currently, we put out print ads, radio announcements, television announcements, as well as attend in-person events.
